VACCINE STATISTICS

COVID-19 Vaccines During Pregnancy

 COVID-19 vaccination among pregnant people is associated with about a 60% reduced risk of COVID-19 hospitalization in infants younger than 6 months old. (Source: <u>CDC</u> <u>MMRW</u> Report). According to CDC data, only 31% of pregnant people have been vaccinated against COVID-19 and vaccination rates vary significantly by race and ethnicity (Source: <u>CDC</u> Statement on Pregnancy Health Advisory).

Tdap Vaccine During Pregnancy

- Getting a Tdap vaccine between 27 through 36 weeks of pregnancy lowers the risk of whooping cough in babies younger than 2 months old by 78%¹ (Source: <u>CDC Pregnancy</u> and Whooping Cough).
- CDC data continues to show persistent racial and ethnic disparities in vaccination coverage among pregnant women. Receipt of both flu and Tdap vaccines was reported by 30.7% of women with a recent live birth overall, but only among 17.7% of Black women compared with 33.3% of White women (Source: CDC Flu and Tdap Vaccination Coverage Among Pregnant Women United States, April 2021).

Flu Vaccine During Pregnancy

- Getting a flu shot can reduce a pregnant woman's risk of being hospitalized with flu by an average of 40%. (Source: <u>CDC Influenza (Flu) Vaccine and Pregnancy</u>).
- Vaccination reduces the risk of flu-associated acute respiratory infection in pregnant people by about one-half (Source: <u>CDC What are the benefits of flu vaccination?</u>).
